

Honors Program Required Course	Advising Information (When and who should take this course)
HNR 110 (4 credit hours)	Incoming Freshman Fall semester (Note, if you did not take HNR 110 because you came into the program after your first semester you can “honorize” an additional class to substitute*)
QLC 175 H (1 credit hour)**	Second semester freshman during Spring semester, to be completed with taking 100 level learning community courses in Gen Ed.
QLC 275 H (1 credit hour)**	Sophomore students completing 200 level learning community courses in either semester.
QLC 375 H (1 credit hour)**	Junior students completing 300 level learning community courses in either semester.
HNR 400 (2 credit hours)	Upper level Junior, or Senior students can complete this in Fall or Spring semesters.
QCP 400 H (2 credit hours)	Upper level Juniors and Seniors should complete this course once they have finished all other Gen Ed requirements and learning communities. This course is offered both Fall and Spring
Departmental Course for Honors credit (“Honorized” course)*	Upper level students who have identified a particular class they would like to dig deeper into. See contract information below. This can be completed with either Fall or Spring semesters.
Departmental Capstone Course for Honors credit (“Honorized capstone”)	Upper level students completing their departmental capstone course. Can be completed either semester.

*Honorized courses are accomplished by turning in a contract where the student and instructor of the course agree to the terms by which this course will meet honors learning outcomes. The honors chair sends specific information on how to turn in contracts at the beginning of every Fall and Spring semesters.

**Only two QLC X75 H honors seminars need to be completed.
